

COVID-19 Update- 14th May 2021

Dear Parents/Carers

Following the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday regarding the next phase of the roadmap out of lockdown on Monday 17th May, this letter is to update you on the changes to our safer working protocols. The safety of our pupils and staff remains our top priority.

The main focus of these changes relates to the use of face coverings. We are currently reviewing any further changes to our operation and revising our risk assessment. Any further changes will be communicated to you to be in place after May half term.

From Monday 17th May - Face coverings are no longer recommended to be worn by pupils in school. Pupils have the choice to wear them if they wish, this is a personal choice. Pupils will be required to continue to wear them on school and public transport.

The revised guidance states that the reintroduction of face coverings for pupils or staff may be advised for a temporary period in response to particular localised outbreaks, including variants of concern. Should this happen we will inform you.

As we move into this next phase, we need to keep following the hand, face, space and fresh air messages. To keep our schools open, we all need to do our parts. It is vital that your child plays their part in keeping themselves, their peers and our staff safe by:

- Washing their hands regularly for 20 seconds and using hand sanitiser.
- Socially distancing: staying at least 2 metres away from our staff and pupils who are not in their bubble.
