Just before and during the Half Term period, there have been a number of confirmed cases of coronavirus in the Year 9 class bubbles at The George Eliot School. The Warwickshire County Council Public Health Team has increased its contact tracing and PCR testing efforts given the recent developments in relation to the VOC-21APR-02 in Nuneaton and Bedworth. As part of this, we have been keen to identify all potentially asymptomatic COVID-19 positive cases in school settings. We are therefore kindly asking for your help as we aim to contain the spread of the VOC-21APR-02 in our communities. To do this, we kindly request that all pupils in year 9 and their households take a COVID-19 PCR test.
