

Dear Parents and Carers

Remote Learning for Years 8 and 9

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic we have worked hard to minimise the disruption to learning and maintain full time provision either in school or remotely. We have needed to make the difficult decision to move years 8 and 9 onto remote learning until Friday 8th October 2021, returning to face-to-face learning on Monday 11th October. During this time pupils should not attend school and instead access lessons remotely using Microsoft 365, and the accounts previously issued. We acknowledge that this decision will impact on families, however as you will appreciate, we are operating in a national context in which the increased number of COVID cases continues to impact schools. If you are a keyworker and require support, please contact us.

We would encourage you to get your child a PCR test this week.

Pupils in Years 7, 10 and 11 should continue to come to school as normal.

All pupils are already confident in accessing Teams. Our pupils also make extensive use of Educake and Hegarty Maths. These platforms support pupils to progress through the topics and allow the teachers to give feedback to pupils. In the first instance and immediately from tomorrow pupils should access their assignments and there will be work set on there from their class teachers. Pupils will all be emailed a plan showing a mixture of pre-recorded lessons and 'live' check-ins that we will operate for support.

All pupils are expected to engage in the on-line learning and registers will be taken regularly to monitor that pupils are meeting the expectations. Staff are available for support and pupils can use email system to contact their teachers, or you can use the homeworkges@midlandat.co.uk for any questions that will come through to a senior member of staff.

Please can we also take this opportunity to remind you of the following COVID-19 measures to support our community:

If your child has any of the COVID-19 symptoms as shown below they must not attend school and you should book a test.
