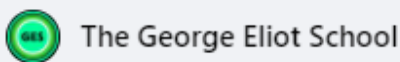



The George Eliot School's offer to pupils

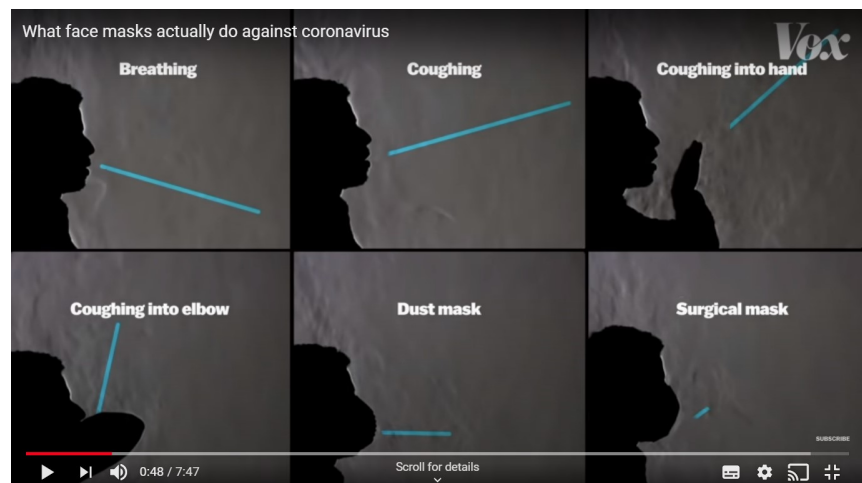
Hands, Face, Space in school

All pupils have been shown this video during their PSHE lessons which details the scientific evidence in support of the need for masks in school, regular hand washing and social distancing. We would recommend that all parents watch this video also, which can be found here: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=P27HRCIMf2U>.

It is a requirement of all pupils to:

- Wear their face mask at all times that they are out of a classroom environment. They can take them off to eat and drink, and then must put them back on.
- Wash their hands regularly, or use hand gel which is available in all classrooms and corridors.
- Maintain social distancing during break, lunch and before and after school. In lessons and line ups, all pupils are in rows facing forwards which significantly reduces the risk of transmission. At other times, we often see pupils very close together, face to face and without masks on, which significantly increases risk.

We are urging all members of our school community to come together and to take responsibility for the safety of each other, our families and our wider community.

Absence procedure reminder

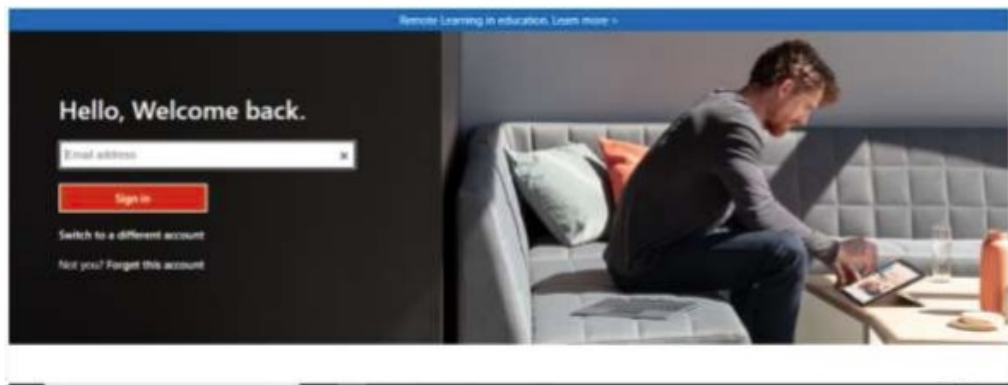
Please remember that any absence of a pupil should be reported via a phone call to the school or a message via MyEd. Please do not email the school for absences.

How To Login To Teams

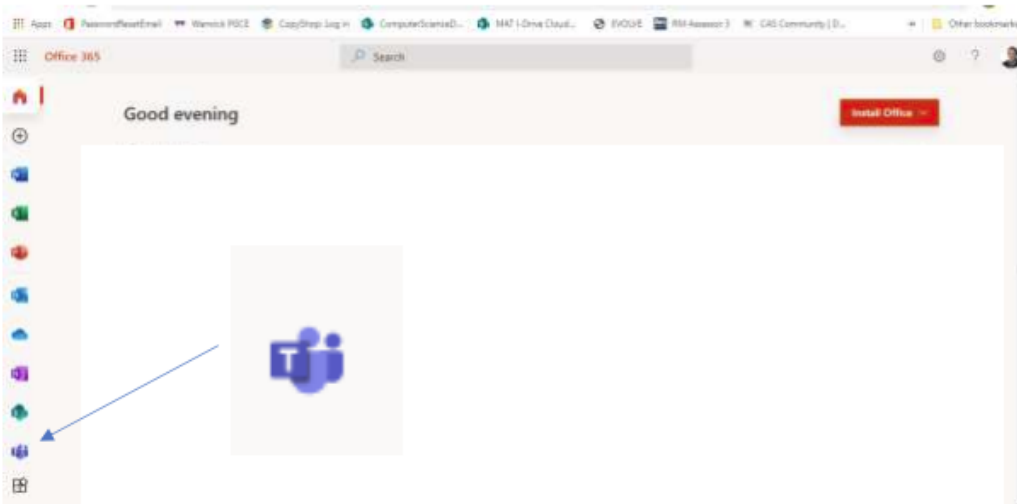
